TECHNICAL NOTE:

Covered Private Employment includes employees covered under the New Mexico Unemployment Compensation Law (UI). Government workers are included in separate employment tables by county and combined industry totals. In January 1978, the New Mexico Unemployment Compensation Law extended coverage to workers in agriculture, households, non-profits and most State and Local Government entities. Coverage is now approximately 97 percent of total non-agricultural workers. Also included in this publication are federal workers covered under the Federal Employees Compensation Act (FECA).

Average weekly earnings cover both full and part-time employees covered under UI Law. The average earnings are "Gross", reflecting incentive wage rates, premium pay for overtime and shift differentials.

Exclusions from UI coverage include such activities as insurance and real estate agents paid on a commission basis; services performed for a school, college or university by a student enrolled and attending classes at that institution; services performed in the employment of a church or convention or association of churches; and services performed in agricultural labor when the employing unit does not meet the employment and payroll requirements for coverage.

Efforts are made to insure that release of industry level employment and wage data conform to the confidentiality provisions of the New Mexico Unemployment Compensation Law. The Bureau of Labor Statistics guidelines for release of this data is that there must be at least three reporting units in an industry and no one firm has more than 80 percent of monthly employment for the third month of the quarter. This edit is conducted at the two, and one digit industry code level. Data which fail this edit are included in the "NONDISCLOSABLE/NEC".

All employment data in this publication are on a jobs-by-place of work basis.
