JOURNEYMAN APPRENTICE

In need of 1 cable technician. Ideal candidates will have 1 to 2 years of experience pulling and running new cable and can work in construction zones and existing buildings. This person must be willing to take instructions from the lead and will be working in pairs. They need to own basic hand tools (snips, crimpers, pliers, screwdrivers, drills, punch-down tools, etc...). Shift begins as early as 7:00am and this is a typical Monday - Friday shift.

1. Pull Cable and perform work in construction areas.
2. Be able to follow the journeyman's lead and pull, punch-down, and terminate cable.
3. Have basic hand tools and have OSP experience.

The cable technician will be enrolled in a 2 to 3 year-long IEC training course once they are selected at CLIENT. This is first step towards obtaining the journeyman's license. The Cable Technicians will be working in various environments including State of New Mexico Departments, UNM Hospital, APS school sites, and other locations. They are working with low-voltage equipment including video systems, IT cabling, and phone cabling.
