The New Mexico Commission for Community Volunteerism (NMCCV) is recruiting **Peer Reviewers** to read and score New Mexico State AmeriCorps applications for the 2016-2017 Program Year.

Why Participate?

Participating in a review is an excellent opportunity for professional development and service. Peer reviewers will be exposed to new and innovative ideas in their field and engage in the grantmaking process of a major state funder of service and volunteering, while networking with other experts in several professions.

Review Process

Peer Reviewers will be trained to read applications and provide an analysis and rating of the quality of each application based upon established criteria. Peer reviewer comments and ratings are considered in funding decisions that determine how AmeriCorps resources will be distributed to support community partnerships in addressing pressing needs throughout New Mexico.

Training for reviewers will take place **Friday**, **May 27**th, **2016**, **1:00-2:00pm**, with submission of final reviews by **9:00am**, **June 10**th, **2016**.

Total time commitment is 12-24 hours total, depending upon your reading pace, over a two-week period.

This is a volunteer activity and no monetary compensation will be given.

How to Apply

To be considered, you must complete and submit an application form and a resume to NMCCV. Those interested in being considered as a peer reviewer should contact **Curtis Cannon** and apply by **5:00pm on May 13th**, **2016**.
