RE: 2019 Prevailing Wage Rates

Pursuant to the Public Works Minimum Wage Act Policy Manual, the Labor Relations Division of the New Mexico Department of Workforce Solutions (Division) is currently requesting and gathering information necessary in order to issue prevailing wage and fringe benefit rates for calendar year 2019. By close of business, July 31, 2018, all interested parties should submit to the Division current collective bargaining agreements, written data, personal opinions and arguments supporting changes to the prevailing wage rate and prevailing fringe benefit rate determination, pursuant to NMSA 1978, § 13-4-11(B). Collective bargaining agreements submitted to the Division must be accompanied by a signed statement certifying under penalty of perjury, that the agreement submitted is fully executed and in effect. Such statement is not required if the agreement is a signed original or photocopy of the signed original. The Division reserves the right to request a certifying statement as it deems necessary.
